

As a member of the Montefiore Health System, Montefiore Nyack is participating in system-wide initiatives designed to support cost-effective management of assets and building space. These projects further Montefiore's vision of being a premier academic health system with state-of-the-art facilities.

Enterprise Asset Management (EAM) is one of the projects that fall under the larger umbrella referred to as the ERP Business Transformation program.

EAM Initiatives include:

- CMS a new asset management tool
- Starfish Assets a new inspection, testing and maintenance plan library
- Starfish Spaces a new space register and visualization tool

The EAM team has begun onsite work at Montefiore Nyack to gather the data for these systems. Most recently, a mobile robotic scanner was deployed throughout our entire campus and satellite offices to capture images that will be used to create a 3D model of our entire physical workspace. The second phase of this project, set to begin in October, involves tagging the Hospital's engineering assets with QR codes for better inventory tracking and retrieval.
